1 Open Forum

- 1.1 Cllr Palfreeman explained that this would last for a maximum of 15 minutes, before the meeting formally started. It provided the public an opportunity to comment on the agenda items.

2 Apologies Received

- 2.1 Cllr Palfreeman opened the meeting at 7:32 p.m. and welcomed everyone to the meeting. He asked for any apologies. Apologies received from Cllr Stopps (family commitments) and Cllrs Moore & Saunston (ENC meeting). Cllr Palfreeman proposed these be accepted and were so agreed by the Council.

3 Declarations of Interest under Section 50 of the LGA 2000

5 Update on Code of Conduct

The Clerk advised that the statutory notice had been displayed in *Nene Valley News*, the Standards Board for England had been informed and had acknowledged our adoption, and all the Councillors had completed their declarations of acceptance and their register of interests. The register had been sent to the ENC Monitoring Officer, with a copy held by the Clerk for local inspection.

The Standards Board had sent a short video on the register, which was on circulation. Councillors were reminded that they have 28 days to notify any changes once they are aware of them. A consultation document was on circulation regarding investigations in alleged misconduct and the punishments thereof. A response document from the ENC Standards Committee was also on circulation.

The Clerk requested the Council identify which Councillors represented the Council on other bodies (since these Councillors will not have prejudicial interests under the code of conduct).

Cllr Foulger is the representative on the Sawyers Charity Committee

Cllr Logue is the representative on the Village Hall Committee

6 Planning Matters

- 6.1 **EN/02/00335/CWN – Single & two storey extensions to the RAF Chelveston Housing Annex (For information only).**

Cllr Palfreeman explained that Defence Estates had notified ENC of the intention to upgrade the housing stock on the Annex. The notification was for information only, since the application is covered by Crown Exemption.

- 6.2 **NCC – Temporary Road Closure Order – Newton Rd, Caldecott (For information only).**

Cllr Palfreeman explained that NCC Legal had issued a notice of an intended order to closure the Newton road in Caldecott & Rushden for surface repairs for 2-3 days. The Clerk had advised NCC Legal of an error in the notice and this will be changed.

- 6.3 **EN/02/00256/FUL - Hargrave Mast**

The Clerk had attended the ENC Planning meeting on Wed 3rd July and confirmed that ENC had refused this application.

- 6.4 **EN/02/00438/FUL - Hillside Development**

The Clerk advised that a second letter had been submitted to the case officer, pointing out the existence of the public Right of Way across the land, by virtue of it being used for 20+ years without objection by the landowner (ENC). The Clerk asked the Council to consider if the Willow tree should have a Tree Preservation Order placed on it. The ENC Planning meeting is likely to be 31st July, when the Chairman & Vice-Chairman are on holiday.

The meeting resolved to instruct the Clerk to take the necessary actions to place a TPO on the Willow tree and attend the Planning meeting on the Council's behalf.

Since the Council also opposed the development, on behalf of all the parishioners, Cllr Palfreeman proposed that Mr Thompson's efforts be adopted by the Council as an official activity and, subject to the provision of a written expenses claim, his expenses incurred in undertaking this task be reimbursed. Cllr Dale added that this action was to be without precedent. Cllr Foulger expressed some concerns about this.

- 7.5 The bank statements for the months of April & May have been received and reconciled.

8 Updates on Projects List

8.1 New Street signs

The replacement signs for “Duchy Close” had finally arrived and been fitted. The Disbrowe Court sign (in wrong place) was awaiting a decision on the boundary of the development, since it appears the developers may have extended the gardens into the Highway land.

An alternate quote for “Children Ahead” signs for Water Lane and a sign to the Village Hall – Cllr Foulger had been unable to contact the appropriate officer, due to holidays. He would continue to try.

8.2 Traffic Calming Measures

Cllrs Dale & Foulger met with Nick Gore (NCC) to discuss traffic calming in Raunds Road. The money (which came from last year’s budget) will be available till the end of this financial year. The site visit proposal was to install the “gate” with road narrowing markings and “SLOW” across the road approx. 50 – 100 yards up the road from the existing limit, so that traffic slowed down by the time they reached the limit – this would reduce noise to the residents of Pretoria Cottages. The existing 30-mph signs to be replaced with larger diameter ones with a yellow backing plate to improve their visibility. The existing cast village sign to be removed (by the Council) and a new village sign installed, which would include “Please drive slowly”. If the Council agreed with this scheme, a formal costing would be prepared, with the optional element of red road markings at the 30-mph limit. Cllr Foulger proposed that the Council agree with the scheme and request a formal costing for the next meeting.

8.3 Street Lighting

Cllr Palfreeman advised that the Clerk had sought an alternate source for street light maintenance. The quote received did not make it attractive to change from ABB. The replacement street light column in Hillside is due to be fitted this week.

8.4 Grass Cutting Contract

Cllr Palfreeman commented this was getting better.

8.5 Village Appraisal 2002

Cllr Dale had produced the draft 2002 questionnaire and asked the Cllrs to look through it and report back at the next meeting, with a view to issuing the appraisal in September.

8.6 Brook cleaning

Cllr Palfreeman advised that the brook was becoming overgrown again by Foot Lane. Cllr Izzard reported the brook by the Raunds Rd was clogged in several places. The Clerk was instructed to contact ENC.

8.7 Millennium Footpath

Cllr Palfreeman advised that the Clerk had written to Higham Ferrers Town Council regarding the state of the footpath in their parish. It should be noted that Town & Parish Councils have a power, but not a duty, to maintain footpaths. The Clerk had also written to the Highways Agency regarding safety of pedestrians crossing the A6 bypass dual carriageway from 2003. Cllr Dale reported that the Raunds Rd footpath needed siding out. The Clerk was instructed to contact NCC/WS Atkins.

8.8 Village Welcome Pack

8.9 Shared Taxi Scheme

Cllr Palfreeman outlined the proposed scheme from NCC, which would run from September to Easter on a trial basis. The scheme offered was not as flexible as the ideas mentioned at the APA, but was a start. The Clerk was instructed to contact NCC and confirm the existing bus service would not be affected by these arrangements.

Cllr Izzard left the meeting at this point.

9 Discussion of ENC Jubilee Grant

Cllr Palfreeman advised that Mr Melvin Wooding was committed to other building projects and would not be able to produce a bench in the timescales permitted (1st April 2002 – 1st October 2002). Cllr Foulger pointed out the Council had missed out on the Millennium grant by not acting fast enough. Cllr Palfreeman proposed the Council purchase a bench from Glasdon, paying the balance of the cost from Council funds.

11 Approval of Chairman's & Clerk's Correspondence Logs

Cllr Palfreeman advised he had no additions to his logs since the last meeting. The Clerk's log was issued to the council prior to the meeting.

12 Councillor's Reports

Cllr Logue advised the meeting that the new owners of 14 Duchy Close intended to set up a care home for disabled/severe learning difficulty children. This may cause some protest from the nearby residents (e.g. parking for 7 staff). Cllr Foulger cited a similar scheme at "Wildacre", where it had been pointed out that for 6 or less residents, planning permission for change of use was not required

Cllr Foulger raised the issue of the A6 bypass and the recent announcements at the NCC Area committee and in the press. Cllr Meeson advised that some of the contractors were due back on site on Wednesday.

The Clerk reported that WS Atkins had been to see the footbridge by the ford and the Culvert in Raunds Road. NCC ROW had carried out repairs to the footbridge in Water Lane, though this would eventually be replaced when funds permitted.

The Clerk advised that Mrs Judy Spencer (a resident of Caldecott) had commented that there was only one litterbin in the village. Cllr Foulger objected to the provision of a litterbin. The meeting agreed to ask ENC to provide a bin, subject to it being sited on the verge next to Mrs Spencer's property.

Post-meeting note: This decision was challenged on the grounds that it could constitute financial business, which is not permitted under Councillor's Reports, since there is no prior notification. The Clerk has sought legal advice from the SLCC Legal Officer and has been advised that financial business only relates to the Parish Council's finances. Accordingly the decision at the meeting is valid.

The Clerk advised that Mr Chris Pentland (a resident of Caldecott) requested the Council contact the NCC/WS Atkins about standing water on the road outside his house. Vehicles pass the water causing it to strike his stone wall, which has lead to deterioration of the bonding cement and a danger of the wall collapsing onto the highway. Mr Pentland has carried out repairs to the wall, but requests that the road is sorted out. Cllr Palfreeman agreed to discuss this with Mr Pentland.
