6 Updates on Projects List

6.1 Highways Issues

The Clerk advised that NCC, as part of the new Motorbike Red Route works, had installed new chevrons along the B645 between the Chelveston Rd roundabout on the A6 and the County boundary.

6.2 305th BG Memorial

Cllr Dale advised of a last minute change of design by the 305th, concerning the triangle and the "G", but the order for the granite had finally been placed in time for the ENC grant. Peter Hill and his brother-in-law had agreed to do the digging for the foundations, subject to confirmation of public liability insurance to the Clerk.

The Clerk confirmed the ENC Heritage grant claim had been submitted and detailed recent donations, bringing the total to over £10,000 in 9 months.

6.5 E-Government

The Clerk advised for the 30 day period till 11th March, 35% of the hits came from the USA and 10% from other countries (New Zealand, Mexico, Germany & France). CPRE Northants had requested a link to their site and had installed a link to the Councils.

7 ENC Electoral wards – final consultation by Boundary Committee.

Cllr Wooding advised the Boundary Committee had announced its draft proposals for the new wards for East Northants. Most of ENC's proposals had been followed, except Higham Ferrers & Rushden, where there appeared to be some confusion with the District wards extending across the town ward boundaries. Chelveston still appears to be in the Higham Ferrers Chichele Ward.

8 Sawyer's Charity Representatives – consideration of candidates.

Cllr Wooding advised the two trustees elected by the Council to the *James & Thomas Sawyer* Charity (240194) would shortly complete their three year term of office (elected 12th May 2003 at the AGM). The Council should consider candidates in time for this year's AGM. Both the existing trustees (Cllr Foulger & Mrs D.Murray) had indicated they would be prepared to serve again.

The charitable purpose is for "the general benefit of the poor persons resident in the parish of Chelveston-cum-Caldecott and also for the benefit of the poor persons resident in the ancient parish of Raunds". Income in the order of £770/year is generated via land owned within the parish.

9 Annual Parish Assembly 2006 – planning the meeting

Cllr Wooding reminded the meeting the APA was scheduled for Mon 10th April 2006. In recent years, the Council had chosen a theme – the Local Development Framework, Safety Camera Partnership, etc as draw to bring in the public. What did the Council want to do this year?

Cllr Dale proposed the APA be delayed until Mon 8th May, following an expected village planning consultation on Weds 3rd May. The AGM would follow.

The Clerk was instructed to contact the applicant regarding advertising the event.

10 Rights of Way report.

The Clerk (as PPW) advised that following the Council's response to the airfield diversion proposals at the last meeting, the landowner had met with the Clerk & Cllr Wooding to discuss the proposals.

The owner had now come up with a third proposal, which again NCC ROW have asked the three Councils to consider. If in agreement, the intention would be to effect the diversion order by the Magistrates Court route. The Clerk outlined the plans and reminded the Council they have a power of veto against such orders.

Cllr Wooding explained why he now felt the proposals to be acceptable. After debate, the meeting agreed to the proposals, subject to confirmation of the open access areas. The meeting instructed the Clerk inform NCC ROW accordingly.
