Minutes of an **Ordinary Meeting** of the Parish Council held at **7:30 p.m. - Monday 11th June 2007** in the Chelveston Village Hall.

Open Forum

David Loveridge spoke about his plans for "Operation Chelveston" on the weekend 27th/28th October 2007 as a 40's weekend. The field at the back of the *Star & Garter* had been central to his plans, but currently in disarray due to the situation with the present tenant. Any profits would be split between RAF benevolent fund, the Ellie Logue appeal, the Village Hall and the organisers.

Cllr Mommersteeg asked what opportunities to link the events on the airfield with Preserve. David Loveridge felt there may be difficulties with this, since he needed the goodwill of the owners. This may include CRE displaying their proposals.

The Clerk asked what insurance cover (e.g. public liability) was in place. David Loveridge advised he did not have cover at this time, as his venue was uncertain. The Clerk advised the Council could not provide cover as this was not a Council organised event.

1 Apologies

- 1.1 Cllr Dale opened the meeting at 7:44 p.m. and asked for any apologies – Cllr Harwood (attending an ENC meeting). The meeting agreed to accept this apology.

2 Declarations of Interest under Section 50 of the LGA 2000

Cllr Dale declared a prejudicial interest in item 5.1 (director of the company).

Cllr Dale also declared a gift, being a limited edition plate presented by the 305th BGMA, which he received on behalf of the parish and suggested it could be hung in the Village Hall.

Cllr Foulger declared a prejudicial interest in item 5.2 (recipient of expenses) and item 5.3 (member of the PCC).

Additionally, all Cllrs received a copy of the latest Standards Board for England guidance document on the Code of Conduct.

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3 Minutes of Previous Meetings

The minutes of the annual meeting of the Parish Council **0706 – 14th May 2007** had been circulated.

The meeting resolved to:

- 3.1 Approve the minutes of meetings **0706** with no amendments.

Proposed: Cllr Wooding Seconded: Cllr Izzard Decision: Unanimous

4 Planning and Licensing Matters

4.1 New applications

The Clerk confirmed there were none.

4.2 Update on previous applications.

The Clerk advised that the next ENC planning meeting was Weds 13th June 2007 and the deferred CRE application would be decided then. The Council had booked a slot to speak and needed to decide who to send. Cllr Foulger volunteered to speak. The meeting agreed and instructed the Clerk to notify ENC accordingly.

Proposed: Cllr Wooding Seconded: Cllr Dale Decision: Unanimous

The extension at *Meadowcroft* had been approved by officer delegation.

The extension to the anemometer mast for a further 12 months at CRE Park and the lawful consent at *Wildacre* were still pending. The Environment Agency had raised an objection to the relocation of Duchy Farm, regarding the slurry pit.

4.3 Residential Land Availability 2007

Cllr Dale advised that there was only one addition to the plan since last year, the outline permission for an in-fill property next to Hall Farm in Water lane.

4.4 Update on the *Star & Garter*

Cllr Dale advised that the present tenant had volunteered to surrender his lease on 21st June 2007. The brewery will close the *Star & Garter* for approx 6/8 weeks for refurbishment, whilst they advertise for a new tenant. The brewery sees potential for the site with the emphasis on food/families that customers drive to, rather than passing trade.

Cllr Dale has spoken to them about "Operation Chelveston" and this was seen as a good marketing opportunity for the re-opened venue.

5 Financial Transactions

- 5.1 The following invoices were due for payment – Creatifica Associates (Dedication service sheets & thank you letter printing) and ABB (Quarterly St Lighting maintenance). The meeting resolved to approve these payments & authorised the appropriate cheques to be signed.

- 5.2 The expenses were claimed – M.L.Foulger (Poppy wreath). The meeting resolved to approve this payment & authorised the appropriate cheque to be signed.

Proposed: Cllr Dale Seconded: Cllr Emerson Decision: Unanimous

- 5.3 The following bodies had made a request for grants - St John Ambulance Service (£100) and Chelveston PCC (£50). The meeting resolved to approve these grants & authorised the appropriate cheques to be signed.

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Proposed: Cllr Wooding Seconded: Cllr Emerson Decision: Unanimous

- 5.4 The following invoices are due for payment for the war memorial – Hockerill Engraving (dedication plaque). The 305th BGMA had agreed reimbursement from the appeal fund. The meeting resolved to approve this payment & authorised the appropriate cheque to be signed.

- 5.5 A full list of the Clerk's expenses was included with the agenda. The meeting resolved to approve the payments & authorised the appropriate cheque to be signed.

- 5.6 In accordance with FR 5.1, the Council's bank mandate details had been updated.
- 5.7 The bank statements for the months of April & May have been received and reconciled.
- 5.8 The Clerk advised the changes to the ENC Precept allocation (i.e. reverting back to the old 50% in May & October system).
- 5.9 The Clerk took the meeting through the first quarter budget control sheets and the following virements were proposed.

The revised budget altered to the actual "Balance Brought Forward" & "VAT refund".

Insurance = +£29.70

Clerk's Salary = -£586.00

Unrestricted Reserves = -£207.00

The meeting agreed to the above changes to the revised budget.

6 Updates on Projects List

6.1 Highways Issues

The Clerk advised that, as requested by Cllr Emerson, NCC had been requested to reduce the "on time" of the speed activated sign on Higham Rd, to enquire the status of replacement of the sign on Kimbolton Rd and to request the replacement of the struck directional sign on the Higham Rd (order has been raised).

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The Clerk advised that, as requested by the Council, the Safety Camera Partnership had been asked to visit the village as part of the 15% "requested allocation" time. The results would be notified later.

The Clerk advised that with the forthcoming decriminalisation of parking and the change to enforcement by the County's contractors (NCP Services) from 1st August, all Town & Parish Councils were being asked to highlight any acute areas that require action. Currently there are no yellow lined parking limitations within the parish (NB. Britten Close has covenanted parking restrictions on the residents, but this is not enforceable to non-resident motorists).

Cllr Foulger (as the parish highways rep) advised that the Atkins/NCC budget for repairs was reported to be low.

6.2 305th BG Memorial

Cllr Dale advised that thank you letters had been sent out to the various organisations and individuals that had helped make the day a success.

A donation had been offered to provide an engraving of the poem "*Memorial of Thanks*" by Margaret Hawkins (that was first read at the dedication service), to be mounted on the wall underneath the dedication plaque. Cllr Dale asked the meeting for approval to place the order. The meeting agreed and instructed the Clerk to act accordingly.

Proposed: Cllr Izzard Seconded: Cllr Mommersteeg Decision: Unanimous

The Clerk advised the Council's insurers had finally agreed to provide cover on the Friday prior to the event. The National Lottery now required a report of its contribution before the funds could be signed off.

6.3 Street Lighting

The Clerk advised no report.

6.4 Ditches

Cllr Foulger advised no problems in the recent rains. The ditch was now hidden from view by vegetation again

Cllr Izzard advised C.Cllr Lawson had been in touch. As summer was approaching, it had been agreed to wait now until the rains returned to see if the problems reoccurred.

6.5 E-Government

The Clerk advised for the 30 day period ending 9th June 2007, 16.7% came from the US, 0.1% from Europe & 4.4% from other countries.

A new web-page had been added to the site to cover the 305th BG memorial dedication service, with copies of the speeches and photos of the day. On Weds 30th May, the new page received 290 hits in one night (212 from the US).

In consultation with Cllr Dale, the computer back-up strategy had been reviewed and the Clerk now wished the Council to purchase a licensed version of WinZip Pro 11 (approx £30). The meeting agreed to the purchase and instructed the clerk to act accordingly.

7 Approval of the Statement of Accounts and the Annual Governance Statement for the accounts ending 31st March 2007.

Cllr Dale advised that Independent internal auditor had approved the accounts with no issues. The Council now needed to approve both the Statement of Accounts and the Annual Governance Statement. Each item was dealt with in turn.

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The meeting agreed to approve both the Statement of Accounts and the Annual Governance Statement for the accounts ending 31st March 2007 and ordered that they be signed accordingly.

Proposed: Cllr Dale Seconded: Cllr Foulger Decision: Unanimous

The Clerk advised the statutory notices had been posted on the noticeboards.

8 Update on the Parish Council Conference held on 24th May 2007.

The Clerk updated the meeting on the second Parish Council Conference, hosted jointly by NCC and Northants Police at Wooton Hall, Northampton.

Cllr Dale asked the Clerk to report on the electorate distribution within the Higham Ferrers Division.

9 Consultation on the ENC Three Towns Plan: Preferred Options & the North Northamptonshire Joint Planning Unit Strategic Developments.

Cllr Dale advised the Three Towns Plan Preferred Options highlighted strong support for the Greenfield status of the former airfield (contested by CRE Ltd). Of concern was a call to modify the development boundary to the north of Britten Close (to the ditch), since this could lead to back-fill development.

The NN JPU consultation did not identify any strategic developments in the parish (the only wind farm listed was the proposed extension to the Burton Wold site).

10 Debate on traffic calming measures and future options

Cllr Dale reminded the meeting that this was one of the key themes from the 2007 APA. At present there were gateways on the B645 Kimbolton Rd and the B663 Raunds Rd. There were larger (yellow backed) 30 signs on all approaches other than Water Lane and 30 roundels on the road on the Kimbolton Rd and the Raunds Rd. Lastly there was a speed activated 30 sign on the Higham Rd.

After debate, the meeting agreed to instruct the Clerk to obtain costs for adding 30 roundels on the road at Caldecott, B645 Higham Rd and Water Lane, as well as joining the "self-use" speed camera rota.

11 Debate on footways & footpaths and future options.

Cllr Dale reminded the meeting that this was one of the key themes from the 2007 APA. At present there were several footways that were broken and/or overgrown.

After debate, the meeting agreed to instruct Cllr Foulger to contact NCC/Atkins to get the footway outside 19 Water Lane repaired and requested Cllr Emerson establish the width of the footway on the Higham Rd.

12 Visits, Training & Courses.

The Clerk advised of the following –

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13 Rights of way Report

The Clerk (as PPW) confirmed the diversion order for MM11 had now been confirmed, as of the 1st June 2007. This meant the ROW no longer went through the tennis courts of *Church House*.

As requested by Cllr Izzard, the broken wooden stile on MM13 at the B645 (Higham Rd), near to Wateryard Spinney, had been removed. The access would now remain as a gap.

Cllr Izzard requested the stile on MM6 on the B663 (Raunds Rd) be replaced as it was broken.

Cllr Izzard requested BCC ROW be contacted regarding the "missing link" footpath from the former airfield to Yelden.

Cllr Foulger requested NCC & BCC ROW be contacted about the lack of ROW signage on the former airfield.

14 Approval of Chairman's & Clerk's Correspondence Logs

14.1 The meeting resolved to approve the Council Correspondence Logs and the various actions required dealing with each item.

Proposed: Cllr Foulger Seconded: Cllr Wooding Decision: Unanimous

15 Councillor's Reports

The Clerk advised Cllr Foulger had requested additional time to make further copies from the "*Book of Governors*" before it was handed over for depositing at the County Records Office.

The Clerk advised that the Council now appeared to meet 5 of the 7 QPS criteria (elected Cllrs, qualified Clerk, meetings, accounts & ethics). Of the remaining two areas (communications and Annual Report), the Clerk felt this could be addressed by an additional newsletter before July (i.e. in between the bi-monthly newsletters) to specifically cover the Annual Report. The aim would be to apply for QPS accreditation by September.

The Clerk advised the June/July newsletter had been issued. As requested by Cllr Wooding, the issue of horse/ponies being ridden on footpath MM15 was covered.

Cllr Wooding asked when the road sweeper was due in Caldecott, as it had visited Chelveston a few days earlier.

Date of Next Meeting:

An Ordinary Meeting of the Council would be held on 9th July 2007 in the Chelveston Village Hall.

The meeting closed at 9:00 p.m.
