1 Introduction & Apologies.

Cllr Dale welcomed everyone to the meeting and explained that this was a meeting of the parish (rather than the Council). Apologies were received from D.Cllr P.Whiting.

2 Minutes of the Annual Parish Assembly held on 14th May 2007.

Cllr Dale outlined the minutes of the previous meeting. Glenn Harwood proposed and Jenny Harwood seconded the adoption of the minutes. Cllr Dale & the Clerk then signed the minutes.

3 The NCC and BCC MWDF consultations in respect to the former airfield.

Pieter Mommersteeg (Chairman of Preserve) gave a detailed presentation of the various waste processes that the site may be used for and the urban spine approach to waste locations. He highlighted the grounds that the site should be objected to – the proximity principle (waste disposal near to waste source), excessive traffic (HGV movements etc), building on a Greenfield site and the cumulative effect (e.g. CRE, Biogen and Chettles).

Questions from the floor included the containment (or failure thereof) of liquid wastes, the consultation process, the number of other potential sites, animal culling (carcass disposal of) and existing Biogen plant in Bedfordshire.

Pieter Mommersteeg and Chris Pentland urged the meeting to fill in the consultation response cards distributed by Preserve and/or write a letter to the two county planning teams.

4 Any other matter the Electorate wish to debate.

Cllr Dale asked the meeting about any other matters they wished to raise. None raised.

5 Summary of the meeting.

Cllr Dale summarised the meeting and thanked the residents for attending.

The meeting closed at 8:45 p.m.
